Gospels: What is the good news Jesus brings?

- Gospels means "Good News."
- The four gospels are Matthew, Mark, Luke and John and they are in the New Testament.
- The Gospels tell us the story of Jesus' life and teaches us how to be one of God's people.
- Jesus chooses Matthew the tax collector to be one of his twelve disciples. This teaches us to be friends to the outcasts and love everyone.
- On the Big Frieze I can find: Jesus' disciples spread the good news.



Incarnation: Why does Christmas matter to Christians?

- Incarnation means: God in the flesh.
- Advent means getting ready. In advent Christians get ready for the birth of Jesus.
- Most Christians believe Jesus was born as a baby in Bethlehem.
- Jesus' birth showed he was extraordinary because: Angel Gabriel visited Mary; Angels visited shepherds to tell the good news and shepherds worshiped Jesus as a King.
- On the Big Frieze I can find: the Nativity scene.



Salvation: Why does Easter matter to Christians?

- Salvation means rescue.
- Christians believe Jesus died on a cross to save (rescue) us.
- On Palm Sunday, Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey and was celebrated as a king.
- Judas betrayed Jesus and Jesus was crucified.
- On Easter Sunday, Jesus' body disappeared and the tomb was empty. Jesus was resurrected (rose again.)
- On the Big Frieze I can find: the cross.



God: What do Christians believe God is like?

- A parable is a story told by Jesus that helps people learn new ideas.
- In the parable of the Lost Son, it says that God will forgive everybody if they are sorry.
- There are four types of prayer. Praise, Sorry, Ask and Thanks.

Judaism: What stories about Moses do Jewish and Christian people love to remember?

- The story of Moses is in the Bible and the Torah (Holy Books.)
- The Torah contains stories from the Old Testament.
- Moses was a prophet because he spoke to God and shares his message.
- Moses received the 10 commandments (rules) on tablets on Mount Sinai.
- Moses led God's people out of slavery in Egypt. Jewish people celebrate Passover which celebrates this.
- On the Big Frieze I can find: the ten commandments tablet.
